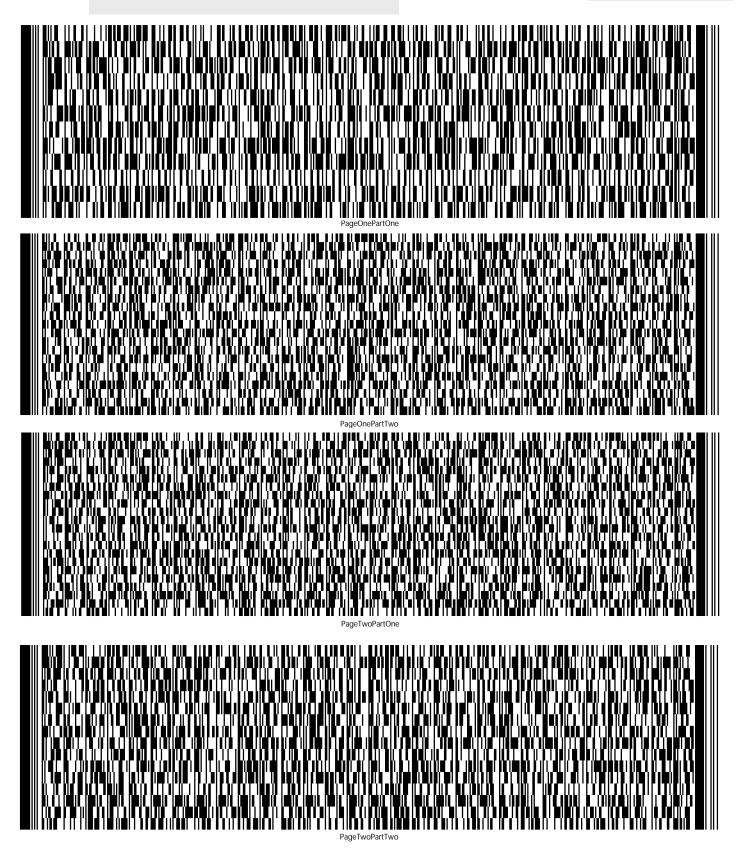
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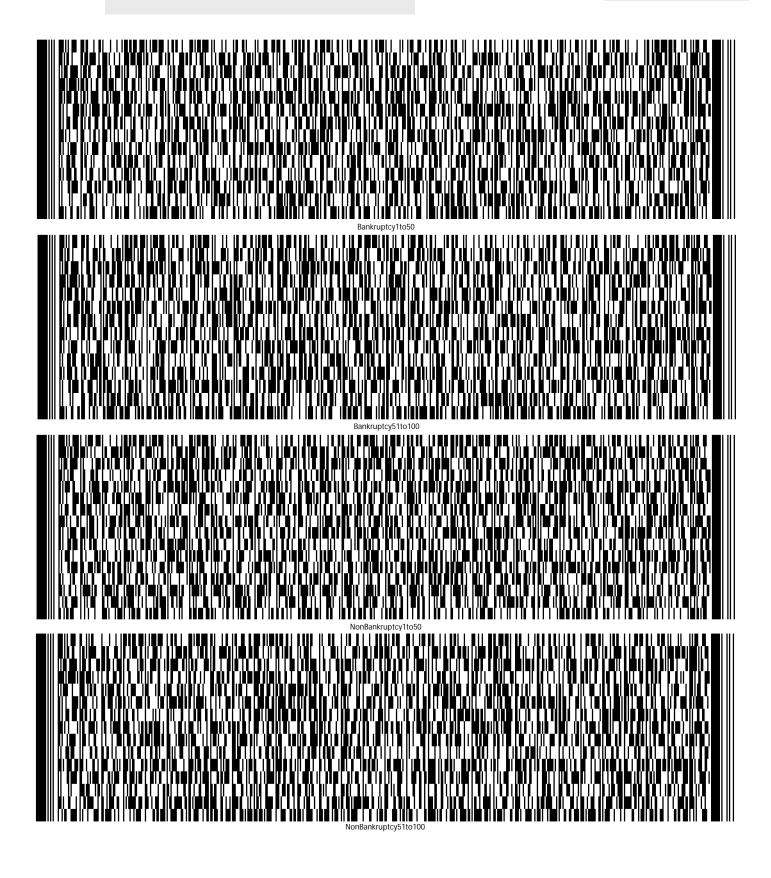

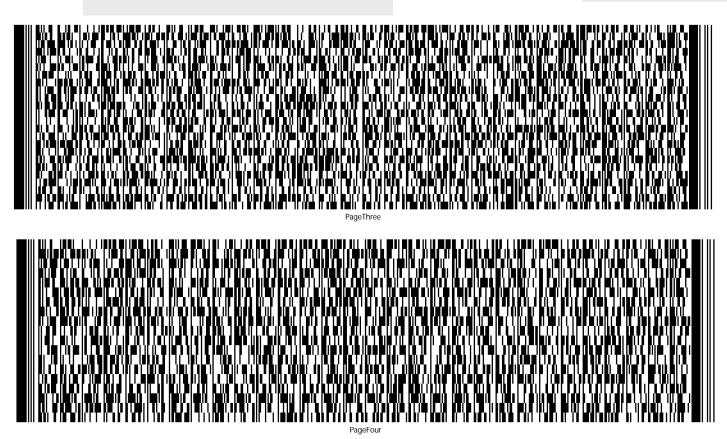

Upon receipt of any additional financial records, the Debtors believe the financial information presented could be subject to material change.

This MOR is limited in scope, covers a limited time period, and has been prepared solely for the purpose of complying with the monthly reporting requirements of the Debtor's chapter 11 case.

The Debtors continue to evaluate and allocate invoices between prepetition and post-petition periods for income statement and balance sheet presentation as they become available and known to the Debtors. Given the Debtors' use of a third-party managing agent and limitations on information made available directly to the Debtors, inadvertent errors or omissions may have occurred. Further, the Debtors' Chief Restructuring Officer's investigation of the Debtors' operations and its finances is ongoing. The Debtors therefore reserve the right to amend or supplement this MOR, as necessary.

CBCCI Liquidating, Inc. and CBHC Liquidating Company do not have any operations, do not maintain accounting records separate from the records of CBCRC Liquidating Corp., and do not maintain bank accounts.
