## STATUS REPORT FOR JUNE 18, 2013 STATUS CONFERENCE

Brian A. Bash, Trustee herein, submits the following summary of the status of the Trustee's administration of the estate:<sup>1</sup>

#### **Recent Recoveries For the Estate**

Since the last status conference in May 2013, the Trustee has recovered an additional \$67,907.40 for the estate, including \$18,333.00 in proceeds from Trailer Acquisition and \$47,354.40 from Duvera Billing Services. The Trustee has filed or will be filing motions to compromise in connection with settlements entered into after the last status conference. As of June 14, 2013, the balance in the money market account maintained by the Trustee for the benefit of the Debtor's estate is \$6,025,163.41.

#### Parma Acquisition Corp.

Parma Acquisition Corp. (a/k/a "CCG") is the borrower under a note from Fair Holdings, Inc., which note is secured by all of CCG's equipment. CCG is at the end of its facility lease and is selling all of its remaining equipment to Midwest Rubber. CCG stored books and records of Durham and many of his enterprises. The Trustee took possession of those books and records on May 16, 2013, moving them to a storage facility. They fill a 12 x 35 foot storage space.

CCG has sold equipment to third parties from time to time. In connection with each sale, CCG turned over 100% of the proceeds of the sale, and the Trustee released Fair Holdings' security interest on the equipment sold. The Trustee commissioned an appraisal to make sure that in each case the sale was commercially reasonable. In each sale, the price was at least fair liquidation value and netted more because there were no expenses of sale deducted. The estate received \$18,500 of proceeds in December

The Trustee and his professionals have addressed and resolved many of the administrative issues in this matter. This list is not exhaustive, but focuses on the issues most significant to ass

2012, and \$3,600 of proceeds in March 2013. The Trustee expects to receive \$174,950 from the sale of CCG's remaining equipment to Midwest Rubber.

The Trustee is not compromising his claim against CCG under the note. There will be a substantial balance remaining under the note after receipt of the sale proceeds.

#### The Trustee's Collection Efforts on Default Judgments

On April 23, 2013, the Trustee filed a motion asking this Court to issue a report and recommendation recommending entry of default judgment against Fair Holdings, Inc. and DC Investments, LLC in the total amount of \$141,116,304.88. That motion is pending before this Court.

On May 2, 2013, the District Court accepted this Court's recommendation of sanctions against adversary defendants Dana Osler ("Osler") and Geist Sports Academy, LLC ("Geist") in the form of a default judgment. Accordingly, default judgment has been entered against Osler and Geist in the collective total amount of \$711,565.00.

On May 28, 2013, the District Court accepted this Court's report and recommendations and entered default judgment against Timothy Durham in the amount of \$134,837,533.14 and default judgment against James Cochran in the amount of \$9,756,084.40. The Trustee will domesticate these judgments, and he plans to begin collection actions to recover any assets available to satisfy those judgments.

The total amount of default judgments obtained by the Trustee is \$193,671,716.28, inclusive of \$48,366,533.74 in Group B default judgments and \$145,305,182.54 in Group A default judgments. A spreadsheet identifying the adversary proceeding number, judgment debtor(s), default judgment date, amount and summary of collection strategy for each judgment is attached as **Exhibit A** to this status update.

Certain individuals have contacted the Trustee and expressed interest about purchasing certain assets belonging to Durham and/or the Estate. The Trustee is pursuing negotiations on the potential sale of those assets, assuming the ability to foreclose once the judgments become final and are domesticated.

The Trustee has targeted eleven judgments for domestication, including the new judgments against Durham and Cochran. The judgment debtors in these cases either appear to be collectible based

on a preliminary examination <u>or</u> have very large judgments against them. The total amount of these judgments is \$168,484,929.03. The Trustee has domesticated five of these judgments in the states of Indiana, South Carolina, and California. The Trustee is also in the final stages of domesticating a judgment against Durham in Texas, a state where he is believed to hold assets. The Trustee has filed two motions seeking court approval to retain local counsel in Mississippi and Georgia. Once the Court approves those motions, the Trustee will have local counsel proceed swiftly with domestication of judgments in those states.

One judgment is against individuals who are believed to be British nationals. The total amount of this judgment is \$205,997.77. The Trustee is still considering the need to retain an experienced professional to assist with collection against these foreign judgment debtors.

The Trustee is focusing his collection efforts on the judgment debtors with the eight largest outstanding judgments. The total amount of these judgments is \$184,127,060.53. In December 2012, the Trustee issued a total of 12 document subpoenas to banks that are or were associated with several of these judgment debtors. The Trustee has received responses to all but one of those subpoenas. The Trustee continues to be in discussions with the only non-producing bank to arrange for production of responsive documents and expects those discussions to result in the production of responsive documents soon. The Trustee also plans to pursue bank garnishments against the six largest judgment debtors.

The Trustee has used the information from the documents that were produced as a result of these subpoenas to pursue claims against persons or entities who received money from those judgment debtors, including, but not limited to, subsequent transferee claims. On May 31, 2013, the Trustee filed two adversary proceedings seeking recovery of subsequent transfers from certain default judgment debtors. The Trustee is in the process of serving those complaints, and the pretrials in those cases are set for July 10, 2013. The Trustee is also continuing his investigation of other potential subsequent claims and may bring additional claims later this year.

The Trustee conducted asset searches on all "high value" cases. The Trustee has deferred pursuit of ten judgments that have been classified as "low value" judgments. The total amount of these "low value" judgments is \$1,055,304.83. The Trustee will reevaluate whether there is any benefit to the estate

in pursuing collection of the "low value" judgments based on the success of his collection efforts in the other default cases.

### **Status of Litigation**

The chart attached as **Exhibit B** includes a list of all pending litigation as of June 13, 2013, including those cases that have been settled or otherwise resolved by the Trustee, with information on the corresponding settlement amount or resolution. Additional descriptions are provided below.

Fortress. Written discovery has closed in the Fortress litigation and the parties have proceeded to depositions. The parties have taken 38 fact witness depositions in the case. The Trustee will continue to engage in discovery in this case, and he believes that all fact discovery will be timely completed. The Court has scheduled a status conference for the Fortress litigation, which will be held on June 18, 2013.

There are six open motions pending in the Fortress litigation before Judge Shea-Stonum. On January 7, 2013, the Trustee filed a *Motion for Leave to File Second Amended Complaint* (docket no. 135) to, among other things, add a common law punitive damages claim. Fortress filed a *Motion for Leave Instanter to File Supplemental Submission In Opposition to Plaintiff's Reply in Support of Plaintiff's Motion for Leave to File Second Amended Complaint on February 12, 2013 (docket no. 142).* 

The Ohio Division of Securities filed four motions to quash subpoenas issued by Fortress and the Trustee to Mark Heuerman and Michael Miglets on May 31, 2013 and June 7, 2013 (docket nos. 148, 149, 151 and 153). The Trustee and Fortress have filed objections to the Ohio Division of Securities' motions to quash.

Judgment in Osler / Geist Sports Academy Litigation. On February 14, 2013, Judge Gaughan accepted this Court's Report and Recommendation sanctioning defendants Dana Osler and Geist Sports Academy, LLC for discovery violations by entry of default judgments totaling more than \$700,000. That disposes of all the Trustee's claims in this adversary proceeding except a negligent notarization claim against Elizabeth McClure, which the Trustee is negotiating to settle. On May 2, 2013, Judge Gaughan agreed with this Court's Report and Recommendation to certify the judgment against Osler and Geist Sports Academy as a final judgment under Rule 54(b).

# The Remaining "Group A" Cases:

The following are the other active and pending Group A cases:

- 1. Litigation against the former legal advisor for Fair Finance, Ronald Kaffen (approximately \$180,000);
- 2. Litigation against John Head, a former officer of the Debtor (approximately \$2.5 million in claims);
- 3. Litigation against Ricky Snow, a former officer of the Debtor (approximately \$1.7 million in claims).

In the litigation against Ronald Kaffen, the Trustee's counsel has taken the depositions of both Ronald Kaffen and his law firm, both of which are defendants in the litigation, and the Trustee's counsel has requested and obtained additional records from Mr. Kaffen relevant to Fair Finance and the claims at issue in the litigation. The remaining fact witness depositions in this litigation are being coordinated with the fact witness depositions in the Fortress matter in accordance with the Case Management Order entered in the Kaffen matter.

The continuing discovery in the litigation against John Head and Ricky Snow likewise is being coordinated with the discovery taking place in the Fortress litigation. The joint motion filed by counsel for the Trustee and John Head requesting the Court line up the case deadlines in that matter with those in the Fortress litigation to ensure efficiency and consistency in the discovery period was granted on January 18, 2013. Mr. Head sat for deposition in the Fortress litigation on May 21-22, 2013. He will sit for deposition in the fraudulent transfer case against him at a mutually convenient date. In the litigation against Ricky Snow, the Trustee and counsel for Mr. Snow have agreed to settlement terms and documentation, which is pending signature by the incarcerated Mr. Snow and will be presented to the Court for approval.

# "Group B" Cases

The one hundred and twenty-six (126) cases in the "Group B" category of cases include claims based on non-debtor transfers, loans or preferential transfers for which actions were filed after November 2011. These cases include the following:

1. **Fraudulent Transfer or Contract Claims:** This group of cases includes one hundred and seven (107) lawsuits. Of those lawsuits, ten (10) remain active and contested and an additional four (4) cases have been stayed, generally because of the defendant's

bankruptcy. The Trustee has settled or otherwise resolved his claims in fifty (50) lawsuits. In addition, a number of defendants in these lawsuits have defaulted, including all of the defendants in forty-three (43) lawsuits and some of the defendants in six (6) lawsuits, and the Trustee has obtained default judgments in most of these cases.

- 2. **Section 547 Claims Against Investors:** The Trustee filed twelve (12) preference complaints against investors. All of these complaints have been settled or otherwise resolved.
- 3. **Section 547 Claims Against Non-Investors:** The Trustee filed seven (7) complaints against non-investors receiving preferential payments from the Debtor. All of these complaints have been settled or otherwise resolved.

The chart attached as **Exhibit B** includes a list of all of the Group B cases status as of June 13, 2013, including those cases that have been settled or otherwise resolved by the Trustee with information on the corresponding settlement amount or resolution. The Trustee is pursuing settlement negotiations in the remaining Group B cases and will continue to prepare those matters for trial, if necessary.

Other Litigation: The Trustee is pursuing recovery for the estate in several other lawsuits involving certain state-law claims, including loan claims and claims against certain insiders of the Debtor. This group of cases includes the only lawsuit filed by the Trustee outside of this district (the *National Lampoon* litigation filed in the United States District Court for the Central District of California, Western Division). These cases include the following:

- 1. The Laikin litigation (approximately \$25 million). The parties to this litigation attended mediation in an effort to settle the Trustee's claims, and those efforts were not successful. The Court subsequently granted the Trustee's motion to reopen discovery in the litigation, and the Trustee has conducted numerous depositions pursuant to that Order, which have and continue to be subject to related motion practice. With the reopening of discovery, the Trustee also discovered that National Lampoon possesses data and documents that National Lampoon previously contended were missing. The Trustee has received more than 60 gigabytes of data from National Lampoon (roughly equivalent to 1500 bankers' boxes) and the Trustee is in the process of retrieving pertinent information from that data. The Trustee was able to tentatively eliminate 83% of the documents produced and obtained significant cost savings as a result. The Trustee anticipates that the matter will ultimately proceed to trial, which has been scheduled for September 16, 2013.
- 2. **The National Lampoon litigation (approximately \$9 million).** National Lampoon has undergone several changes in management since the Trustee commenced his claims, and has employed three different CEOs since 2012. The Trustee is informed that Mr. Durham no longer has any position of management of or control over National Lampoon.

At the last status conference, the Court asked counsel for the Trustee whether she expected that the National Lampoon case would require any extensions of time. Counsel for the Trustee did not expect that a further extension would be needed at that time. Since the last status conference, the Trustee learned that medical issues forced National

Lampoon's lead counsel to withdraw. Given the extensive volume of data National Lampoon's new counsel must become familiar with (described above under the *Laikin* litigation), particularly given National Lampoon's repeated changes in management since 2012, counsel for the Trustee agreed to file a joint stipulation with the Court, requesting an extension of the trial and related discovery dates, on June 4, 2013. The District Court granted the requested extensions on June 6, 2013, setting trial for June 3, 2014. The Trustee and counsel for National Lampoon have been cooperating with respect to the additional discovery and also intend to explore alternatives for resolving the Trustee's claims.

The Trustee was also advised that National Lampoon sued Mr. Durham, his criminal defense attorney, John Tompkins, and Mr. Tompkins' firm, Brown Tompkins Lory & Mastrian. The suit alleges that Mr. Durham embezzled \$1,000,000 in breach of his fiduciary duties and used those funds to pay Mr. Tompkins. Mr. Tompkins and his firm were sued for conversion, fraudulent conveyance and unjust enrichment.

3. The McKibben litigation against insiders of the Debtor and entities they controlled. This Court denied the Trustee's Motions for Summary Judgment against some of the defendants in the McKibben action. On May 24, 2013, the Trustee and Defendants Jeffrey Eglen, Daniel Laikin, James Cochran, Timothy Durham, Rick Snow, John Head and Keith Schaffter filed their Statements of Disputed Facts and, in some instances, stipulations of facts between the Trustee and an individual defendant. (Dkt. Nos. 263-274). The Trustee has not been able to reach a final settlement regarding the dispute over the National Union insurance policy, which has prevented the Trustee from settling with certain of the defendants. The mediator previously employed by the parties is attempting to establish a further mediation date to resolve disputes concerning the National Union insurance policy. The Trustee believes that resolving the insurance policy issues will enable settlements to occur with some of the defendants.

#### **Forthcoming Litigation**

- a) **Subsequent Transfer Claims:** The Trustee expects that some of the defendants in the loan and fraudulent transfer litigation may not have the financial ability to pay the amounts sought by the Trustee. If the Trustee's claims are successful, the Trustee will consider pursuing subsequent transferee claims against transferees of those defendants, in addition to the subsequent transferee lawsuits filed on May 31, 2013.
- b) **Additional Litigation:** The Trustee continues to evaluate additional potential claims that may be pursued for the benefit of the estate, including loan and fraudulent transfer claims for which the statute of limitations will not be expiring until the later part of 2013.

#### Trustee's Focus in the Upcoming Weeks

**Continuing Litigation:** The Trustee's counsel will continue to focus efforts on the litigation of the cases that have been filed by the Trustee to date.
